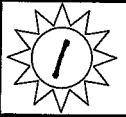
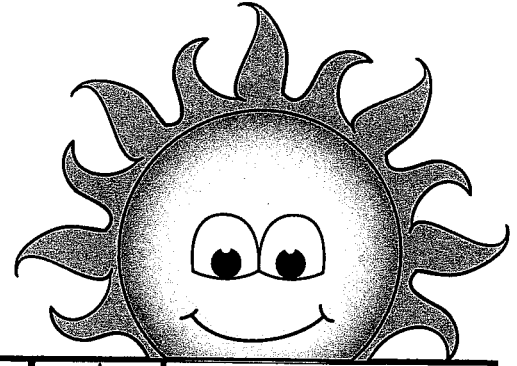

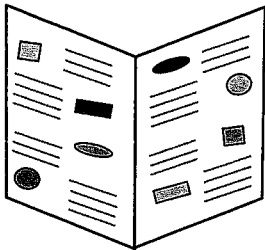
Bright Ideas

in your family would like to order. Add to find the total cost.



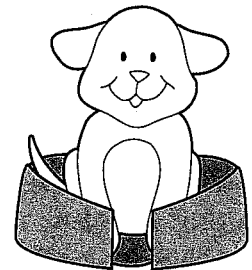
Cut out coupons your family might use. Sort the

coupons into groups, such as frozen foods, canned goods, and snacks. Remind your family to use the coupons when they shop.



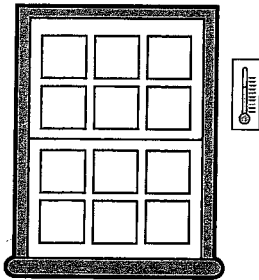
Research the cost of a new pet. Make a list of the costs.

Keep in mind that your pet will need food, shelter, and toys.



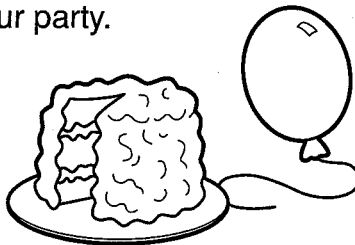
Make a bar graph to record each day's temperature

for a week.



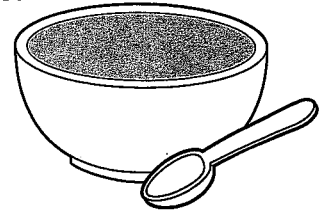
Pretend that you will have a party for some friends. Take a

poll to find out their choice of foods and games. Think about what they like as you plan your party.



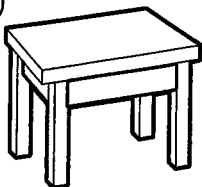
Find a cookie recipe. Find out how many cookies the recipe
