Attached you will find your application/permission form for Sunrise Point's SPLASH Winter Session 2017. You may enroll your child/children in as many classes as you'd like. Please complete and return it to you child's teacher or the office by Tuesday, January 24<sup>th</sup>. All applications for classes received by the end of the day on January 24<sup>th</sup> will be placed into groups according to class choice. Students will then be randomly selected until each class is full. All forms turned in after the date will have a \$5.00 late fee attached.

For bookkeeping purposes, please complete one form for each class your child/children are taking and one check for each class due to insurance reasons. (Checks are Payable to the SPE PTO). No cash please.

Unless otherwise notified assume that your child made it into the class of their choice. If the class/classes you have chosen are already filled, you will receive a notice and your money returned and you will be given the option to enroll in another class. \*(Please note that the SPLASH times are 4-5pm this is when classes will start and end unless otherwise noted. At 3:40 SPLASH students will wait, supervised, in the Blue Pod and eat their snacks until their SPLASH teacher picks them up after end of the school day duties.) When SPLASH classes end you will pick them up in the car line or they will walk home just like normal dismissal. The building will be locked after school and you will not be able to enter the building, your child will come to you.

Please note: All students may bring a snack (peanut free) to their SPLASH session, if they wish. The SPLASH classes will not be providing a snack for their students unless stated otherwise.

Please be respectful of the instructor's class times and pick up your child/children on time. One late warning will be issued, after that a charge of \$5.00 for every 5 minutes late will be expected at the time of pick-up to the teacher of that class who has to wait.
