Reading: Those Shoes

This week we will do a literature study based on the book Those Shoes. Students will review inferencing, use text evidence, use context clues to learn new vocabulary, and complete comprehension activities.

Math: Mental Subtraction

This week we will begin Topic 7 on mental subtraction. We will discuss subtracting multiples of 10, subtracting tens, finding parts of 100 and subtracting on a 100's chart. Remember students have a timed math facts quiz every Wednesday. Please practice with their flashcards at home.

Social Studies: Election Process
