



- **Registration** is complete and fees paid.
- Consider Making an Eagle Fund **donation** to the PTO.
- Place your **school supply** order online or shop on your own. 1st Day School Supplies
- **Health assessment** form completed for all incoming 6th grade and NEW to the district 7th and 8th grade students. All prescription medications require a physician signature and must be on file with the school nurse.
- If your child plans on participating in the following activities next year (**Football, Volleyball, Cross Country, Cheerleading, Basketball, and/or Track and Field**), they will be required to have the following paperwork filled out. If they do not have this paperwork complete, they will not be eligible to participate. (Please reference the downloadable packet at the bottom of this newsletter called KSHSAA PPE (2023)).

In addition to the KSSHAA PPE Packet, you will need to register your student in our online athletic registration system (rSchool). If you have already registered, you do not need to register again! However, you **do** need to replace your existing KSHSAA PPE Packet with the new, up to date packet.
