Board honors Monica Skilling and Jeff Wataha

The Board recognized Monica Skilling, Para II (navigators) at Sunrise Point Elementary, with the Distinguished Service Award. Skilling has been with Blue Valley for 11 years. The Board also honored Jeff Wataha, a technology teacher at Prairie Star Middle, with the Excellence in Education Award. Wataha has been with Blue Valley for 29 years.

Board approves the 2022-23 Legal Maximum Budget and Estimated Tax Rate

In the state of Kansas, all boards of education adopt annually a local option budget percentage resolution. The maximum percent that may be authorized is the statewide average (31%) unless the district has adopted a resolution to exceed the statewide average up to the maximum state-prescribed percent (33%). Board hears summer 2022 construction update

Jake Slobodnik, director of facilities and operations, updated the board on construction work that was done in the schools during the summer. A majority of projects completed this summer were funded by Bond 2020. Check out this video that highlights Bond 2020 projects and the impact it has had on students and staff. Slobodnik reported the total Bond 2020 project costs to date are \$106,826,406, which is \$284,784 under budget.

Board approves crisis alert system, Centegix

The Board heard recommendations from administration on a safety and security system called Centegix. This system would add to the layered approach Blue Valley takes to safety and security. Centegix would provide crisis alert badges for all Blue Valley staff and a system where staff can immediately notify administrators or proper staff of medical emergencies or student emergencies. The badges can also trigger an immediate building-wide lockdown in the event of a security breach to the school. The Board voted to unanimously approve a contract with Centegix. The district plans to implement this system in January of 2023.
