Meeting Called to Order at 4:30 pm

## Welcome

Dr. Mark Schmidt welcomed everyone, then introduced Dan Carney, Director of Safety and Security and Brian Daley, Technology Chief Information Officer

## **Overview of new Centegix Security System in Blue Valley**

Dan Carney and Brian Daley shared information about Centegix, the new Blue Valley Crisis Alert System. The system offers one badge for every Blue Valley staff member. It offers a Staff Alert and a Lockdown Lights-Out alert. This was rolled out in January and has been in operation ever since. ### **Blue Valley Suicide Prevention Intervention Procedures**

Karen Mulligan, Social Worker Supervisor shared information about the protocols following a suicide ideation. She shared information about the Jason Flatt Act, referenced below.

#### JASON FLATT ACT

### Suicide Prevention Plan, Crisis Intervention and Professional Learning

The Jason Flatt Act (KSA 72-8260) was passed by the Kansas Legislature and signed by the governor in spring 2016. As a result of this law, each building will have a crisis plan that will include recognition of suicide ideation, appropriate interventions, and a crisis recovery plan.

Our district has taken a tiered approach offering prevention education to all students, responsive services to those in need, and intervention protocols for those in crisis. Each building also has a comprehensive crisis plan and crisis response team to work with individuals and groups in the event of a crisis. The district also has a crisis response team and FLIGHT Team that support staff and students during and after an event.

**Discussion:** There was discussion around what can be communicated better with parents and students. One comment was that Social Workers mostly hear positive comments. The protocols put in place for a student returning from a suicide ideation, have been a very positive addition to the protocols put in place by BV.

It was suggested that communication to parents about concerns of a student, should come from a classroom teacher first, before an administrator, as they see and know the students better and have a repour with the parents.

### **Open Forum**

Anne Timmons shared that JCCC will host a special screening of "Angst" on March 28<sup>th</sup> at 6pm in the Cap Fed room. <u>Angst</u> Edition is a film program designed to raise awareness around anxiety.
