Naviance Family Connection Elements

- Success Planning—Goal setting, task management, journaling features
- Course Planning—Four-year planning process
 - · Compares course plan to college expectations for academic rigor
 - · Course Description Guide embedded into Program
- Career Planning—Investigate careers related to personality, strengths, skills, and interests; database of career
 information from Department of Labor; Roadtrip Nation video archive
 - · Career Cluster Finder inventory
 - · Career Interest Profiler
 - Strengths Explorer
- College Planning—Research colleges based on personalized criteria of importance; identify colleges that match achievement levels and future plans; research scholarships and enrichment opportunities
 - College SuperMatch
 - · Scattergrams visually demonstrate competitiveness of student performance in specific colleges
 - Senior Graduation Survey
- College Application Process (eDocs)—Digital college application tools for requesting transcripts, recommendations, and other college application paperwork
