


Snapchat


Getting Started

1. [Download the SnapChat App](#)
2. Select Sign Up to create an account or log in to use an existing account.
 - Snapchat is intended for users over the age of 13.
3. Enter in your email address, password and birthday.
4. Pick a username and begin adding friends from your mobile contacts or press Skip.




Take a Photo/Video

1. From the main screen, select the large gray and white circle. To take a video, hold down the camera button and it will begin recording for up to 30 seconds.
 - Adjust the flash and switch to front facing camera modes.
 - The X will delete and allow you to retake the photo/video.
2. Adjust how long the image/video will appear for the person viewing by selecting the timer. Add text, emoji's and drawings to your images and videos.
3. To save your photo or video, select the download feature. The photo or video will save to your camera roll.
4. Adding the photo or video to "My Story" will allow all your friends to view your snaps.
5. Select the arrow in the corner to send to individual friends.



View Snap History/ Chat Feature

1. Swipe right to view your snap history and utilize the chat feature.
 - The Chat feature allows you to have a text conversation through Snap Chat. The messages will disappear after being viewed.
 - Remember snaps and conversations will disappear so you will not be able to view old snaps from users.



2. Select the Chat icon to begin a conversation or swipe left to return to the main screen.

View Snap Stories

From the main screen, swipe left to view Snap Stories.

- Snap stories are built by users. They can be viewed multiple times for a 24 hour period. They will then disappear from your feed.

Settings

1. From the main screen, select the Snap Chat icon at the top.
2. View who has added you as a friend, add friends or view current friends.
3. Select the settings icon to adjust account information, view more information, and adjust actions including log out.
