#### STEP 1 (3/18/24 - 4/3/24)

- 1. Go to the <u>Blue Valley website</u> and select **I am a parent**.
- 2. Enter your Username and Password to access your account.
- 3. Select Course Request from the HOME screen.
- 4. To begin selecting your course offerings you will need to select the blue box at the bottom of the screen that says, "Click here to change course requests".
- 5. You are ready to start searching for course options. You can do this in one of two ways:
  - Type the Course Title in the search field, the available matching courses will display or
  - Type the **Course ID** in the search field, the available matching course will display.
- 6. You are now ready to make your selection. On the desired course, click "Add Request".
- 7. **DO NOT** click "Add Alternate", as we are not accepting alternate choices in the summer.
