

Sight Word Activities for Home

- Word Detectives: Look for words in books, on posters, on signs, in the grocery stores and in newspapers. Have your child highlight the sight words in the newspaper!
- Go Fish: Print 2 sets of the sight words off of our kindergarten school center site. Each person starts with 7 cards. Player 1 asks for a word, if player 2 does not have that word, player 1 draws a card from the stack. The player with the most matched pairs wins!
- Concentration: Use the sight word sets printed off from school center. Lay both sets face down. Players will take turns trying to find a match of the same 2 sight words. The player with the most matched pairs wins!
- Hopscotch: Make a hopscotch grid on the sidewalk with chalk. Write a sight word in each square. Have your child read the word before hopping into the square.
- Writing: There are many fun ways to have your child practice writing sight words!
 - \circ dry erase board
 - o chalk board
 - o sidewalk with chalk
 - use a cookie sheet with a small amount of flour, sugar, corn starch, etc.
 - o shaving cream
 - Rainbow write have your child write a sight word in all the colors of the rainbow
 - Army write try army colors...brown, green, tan, black
 - Halloween or any holiday write choose colors form the closest holiday
- Making sentences: Give your child 1 or 2 sight word cards. Have your child say a sentence or write a sentence using the word or words in the sentence.
