

Nut-Safer Guidelines

At OTE, we have a wide variety of food allergens and restrictions. To remain safe and to prevent exclusion, we don't accept food, including items from the Nut-Safe List, to serve in school or send home with students for birthday celebrations. This complies with our **non-edible birthday celebration**, which is included on page 14 of the OTE Parent Handbook <u>here</u>. Essentially, we must remember that sending food home is a risk for children as they transition between school and home while also putting our families in an undesirable position when a child cannot eat what is provided.
