- All food consumed at the party (party snacks) must comply with the approved Nut Safer List.



Planning for Inclement Weather Days in Blue Valley

Securly Home:

Have you ever wondered how to monitor your child's usage on their Blue Valley device? We have parent tools that will allow you to receive notifications to ensure your child is using their device safely. School staff members monitor these devices during the school day and intervene, when necessary.
