In February, the Facility Planning Board Advisory Committee began meeting to evaluate school boundaries and develop a plan to address elementary school enrollment and building capacity issues. The committee is now seeking feedback from the community.

The proposed boundary adjustments would bring the Glen Abbey & Villas of Chapel Green and Highland Villas & Highlands Creek neighborhoods to Prairie Star Elementary. These proposed adjustments are being considered for the 2024-25 school year.
