It is recommended that you wait until the student receives his/her final schedule before purchasing any additional items on the Elective School Supplies List. Unfortunately due to the varying schedules, these items cannot be included in the EPI kits and must be purchased separately.

Vocal Music:

- Headphones
- Folder with Pockets
- OTMS Music Polo (you will be given information to purchase at the beginning of the year)

Band:

- Concert attire: OTMS Music Polo (will be given information to purchase at the beginning of the year), black dress bottoms, black dress shoes
- Measures of Success book 1 (for 6th Grade)
- Measures of Success book 2 (for 7th Grade)
- Pencils

Orchestra:

- Concert attire: OTMS Music Polo (will be given information to purchase at the beginning of the year), black dress bottoms, black dress shoes
- Equipment- shoulder rest (for violin/viola), rock stop (for cello/bass), cleaning cloth, music stand, rosin, and extra strings.
- Required text-

PHYSICAL EDUCATION**6th, 7th and 8th Gr. REQUIRED OTMS FALCON PE CLOTHING**

These items can be pre-ordered through PTO and picked up at the Falcon Take Off day or delivered to the student in PE class. The PE clothing is organized by the PTO, not the teachers. (FYI - 8th Graders - These items CANNOT be worn at the high school level.) Students can still be wear their older PE clothes for class; they are not required to order new ones every year.

OR

BLUE VALLEY District PE Uniform is a gray T-Shirt and black shorts that can be purchased at Nill Bros., Price Chopper or at Hy Vee Grocery Stores.

Other PE Supplies

- Tennis shoes (a pair to keep in PE locker)
- Socks
- Deodorant (no aerosol cans – stick or roll on)

Any combination of the uniform can be worn. No other T-shirts or shorts can be substituted for the P.E. uniform. The students **first and last name** needs to be **boldly** printed on the front of the t-shirt in the outlined box. On the shorts, in the white box, print first initial of first name and last name.

Any PE clothing that has been altered by rips, cuts, tears, paint, writing etc. can no longer be worn as part of the PE uniform and will have to be replaced at the students own cost.

Students will be going outside for class through the month of November and in the early spring. It is suggested that students keep **sweats or jackets** in their P.E. lockers to wear over their P.E. uniform. Spirit Clothing cannot be worn as a substitute for the PE uniform, but can be worn over their PE Clothes.
