
Mainstage Play - The Outsiders

Volunteers needed for Vision & Hearing Screening



Some November Celebrations & Observances:

- Native American Heritage Month celebrates the rich and diverse cultures, traditions, histories, and ongoing contributions of Indigenous peoples.
- Military Family Appreciation Month honors the military family by recognizing their sacrifices and commitments.
- **Day of the Dead** November 1 celebrated by some with Mexican heritage, a joyful time to remember and honor deceased loved ones.
- All Saints Day November 1 celebrated by some of the Christian faith, this solemn, holy day honors the saints of the church.
- **Diwali** November 12-16 the festival of lights celebrates the triumph of light over darkness, good over evil, and the human ability to overcome observed by some Hindus, Jains, Sikhs, Buddhists, and others. Some will decorate their homes with lights and rangoli art, exchange gifts, dress in colorful clothing, feast with family, and/or go to temple.
