


Final Days for Yearbook Purchase

INTO THE WOODS is a modern classic show featuring everyone's favorite storybook characters in a timeless, yet relevant, piece.



Securely HOME - monitoring your students device

Have you ever wondered how to monitor your child's usage on their Blue Valley device? We have parent tools that will allow you to receive notifications to ensure your child is using their device safely. School staff members monitor these devices during the school day and intervene, when necessary. Some January Celebrations & Observances:

- National Poverty Awareness Month While the United States is considered the richest country in the world, 37.9 million people live in poverty, including 12.5 million children. National Poverty Awareness Month works to bring awareness to issues of poverty and increase access to resources and services. - Maghi January 13 a Sikh celebration. Some Sikh families will celebrate with a recitation of the holy Guru Granth Sahib and
