
Schedule Updates for Tuesdays: March 19th, 26th, April 2nd & 9th

Some March Celebrations & Observances:

- Women's History Month recognizes the achievements and contributions of women to society, culture, and American history. Women's History Month coincides with International Women's Day on March 8.
- World Teen Mental Wellness Day March 2 aims to raise awareness and decrease the stigma of mental health issues among teenagers.



- Ramadan evening of March 10-April 9 the holy month of fasting for the Islamic faith. For some Muslim families, it is a time for introspection, communal prayer, reading the Qur'an, and fasting between sunrise and sunset.
- Holy Week and Easter Sunday March 24-March 31 includes the Christian holidays of Palm Sunday, Maundy (Holy) Thursday, and Good Friday. Some families will attend church services to commemorate the week leading to the resurrection of Jesus Christ on Easter Sunday.
