This past Saturday, The Husky Cross Country team traveled to Raymore, Missouri for the KC Classic. The Huskies went in with big goals knowing that it would be the last meet before Regionals where they were up against some of their most important competition.

The C Team Girls jumped into race mood early in the morning. Sophia Beason led the way with a 5th place finish in a time of 23:01. Beason was followed close behind by Brooke Kreeger who placed 10th in 23:11. Anna



Shaughnessy and Ainsley Novak finished side-by-side with a time of 25:20. The girls snagged 6th place in a 16-team field race.

The boy's team had a strong showing with some new personal bests. Andrew Gafrick led the C team squad with a time of 22:25 with Ethan Crabb close behind him with a time of 22:46. Freshman Andrei Jones had a strong race with a time of 23:02 and Luke Stevens crossing the line alongside him. Sohail and Cody have improved immensely this season, they came across the finish line within 15 seconds of each other. It is evident that the Boys C team is definitely working hard as a team to make their overall score lower each week.

The JV Girls would get an 11th place team standing. Leading the way was Rachel Hostetler in 11th place with a time of 21:53. Lily Schmidt crossed the line in 22:44 landing her a 27th place finish. She was followed by teammate Lizzy Hostetler in 29th with a time of 23:07. Megan Darensbourg came through to get 47th.

Boys JV was led by standout JV Freshman Jey Durham, with a big PR of 19:04. Not far behind Jey was Junior Ben Deardorff with a time of 19:21, a personal best for Ben as well. Terry Lillis had a strong showing on Saturday with a time of 19:42, proving the JV boys worked very hard as a team with times under the 20-minute mark. Next on the team, James McBride had a great time of 20:54 with Josh Clarkson and Kevin Li not too far behind.

The Varsity Girls toed the line in a 263-pack race to come in 7th out of 31 teams. Cecilia Fisher crossed the finish line in 19:01 to get a hard-earned 9th place. Abbey Allen got 31st with a time of 19:56. She was followed by teammate Carly Gagnon who got 44th with a time of 20:20. Lexi Liess, Tayler Williams, Raven Loo, and Laya Erickson all came through the finish shortly after to get the girls in their goal position going into the next meets.

The fog finally lifted but the humidity was still in full effect for the Varsity Boys race. Team leaders Sam Hurley and Drew Mason had stand out performances. Sam finished in 8th place with a time of 16:15 and Drew in 13th place with a time of 16:30. Varsity boys have been focusing on working as a team all week, and they showed that in this race. Jordan Blanchat had a great race with a time of 18:07 respectively. 4th on the team Xavier Brown had a standout performance of 19:10 and close behind him were teammates Keefe Pearson and Jack Rost with times of 19:17. Rounding out the boys' varsity squad is Alex Cross with a time of 19:51.

The JV and C teams will travel to Shawnee Mission Park this Wednesday for an evening race; while the Varsity squad takes a week off from racing to focus on a week of quality training.
