Quarter 2 Report Cards Available on ParentVUE Jan 11th

Grades for Quarter 2/Semester 1 will be available to view by the end of the day January 11. To view your student's grades, you will need to click on the Parent Vue link from the BVMS school web page <https://www.bluevalleyk12.org/BVM> under Parent Quick Links. From there you will sign into your Parent Vue account and then you can select Report Card on the Left side bar. Make sure the Grading Period at the top says December Report Card. At the top left you can change which student you are viewing.

Student Food & Drink Policy

As a reminder, no outside vendor food or drink is permitted inside the school building, including but not limited to: fast food and food delivery services (such as DoorDash).

Student water bottles MUST be labeled with first and last name in either black or silver permanent marker. The front office has Sharpies if students need to borrow one. Water bottles must be resealable and not made of breakable material, such as glass. Students are not permitted to have beverages other than water outside of the lunch room.

Morning Drop-Off Reminders

Here are a few safety reminders for morning drop off:

- To more efficiently keep the car line moving, please use front circle drive and not the parking lot for drop off. Students can be dropped off as early as 7:15am. There is typically no line at this time
- Please do not block the handicap spots by stopping in the lot to unload. Do not pull into the handicap parking spaces unless you are legally authorized to do so.
- Pull all the way forward to the sign "end of drop off/pick up zone." Exit the car on the curbside only. Students should exit when your car stops.
- There is only one crosswalk, which is near the office. A parent/guardian must walk students to the crosswalk to wait for a supervisor to signal when it is safe to cross. Students should not be dropped off in the parking lot without a parent/guardian escort to the crosswalk due to traffic and safety concerns
- Have your student ready to exit the car when you enter the lot to save time

be good to go for basketball. If basketball is the first sport that your

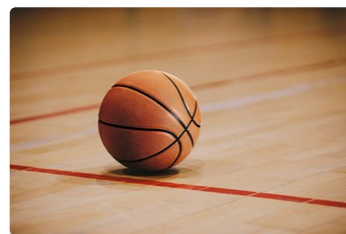
student will be playing this year then we need to make sure to have a physical on file and have your student registered in rSchool.

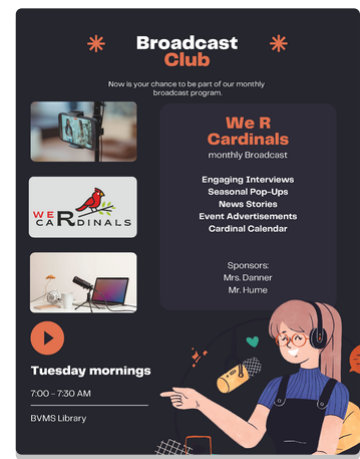
The registration website includes tutorials for athletic/activity registration. Please note that Blue Valley is not using the system for fee collection.

Students participating in athletics, and cheerleading will be required to upload a completed [KSHSAA physical](#), dated after May 1, 2022, with a doctor's signature, and complete all the necessary forms to be able to participate. In addition, any students involved in KSHSAA activities that do not require a physical still need to complete the other required forms to participate. These activities include band/marching band, choir, and orchestra for high school and middle school.

- Highlight of elective options, which can be further explored in the Enrollment Fair

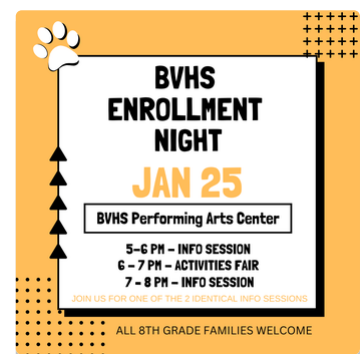
