## A Note From District: Morning Traffic

Here are a few safety reminders for morning drop off:

- To more efficiently keep the car line moving, please use front circle drive and not the parking lot for drop off. Students can be dropped off as early as 7:15am. There is typically no line at this time
- Please do not block the handicap spots by stopping in the lot to unload. Do not pull into the handicap parking spaces unless you are legally authorized to do so.
- Pull all the way forward to the sign "end of drop off/pick up zone." Exit the car on the curbside only. Students should exit when your car stops.
- There is only one crosswalk, which is near the office. A
 parent/guardian must walk students to the crosswalk to wait for a supervisor to signal when it is safe to cross. Students should not be dropped off in the parking lot without a parent/guardian escort to the crosswalk due to traffic and safety concerns
- Have your student ready to exit the car when you enter the lot to save time
