### Learning News

Next week we continue our FRIENDS unit. Our Focus Ouestion will be: How can I share who I am with others? We will review the letters A - L. Our Vocabulary for the week will be a review: SPECIAL PLAY and SPLENDID. Students will be learning 2 new sight words: red & green. Our practice poem will be "Roses are Red." Please review the three pre-decodable books already sent home: "The Park," "Lunch," and "School. (no new paper readers this week) Our learning theme is about THE FIVE SENSES. We will be reading non-fiction books about hearing, seeing, smelling, tasting and touching. In math we have practiced counting, comparing and and ordering numbers 1-5. When we compared groups, it was a bit of a challenge to count and know how many MORE. Try some examples at home ie: If I have 4 crayons and you have 2, how many more do I have than you?
