Communication and Review Process

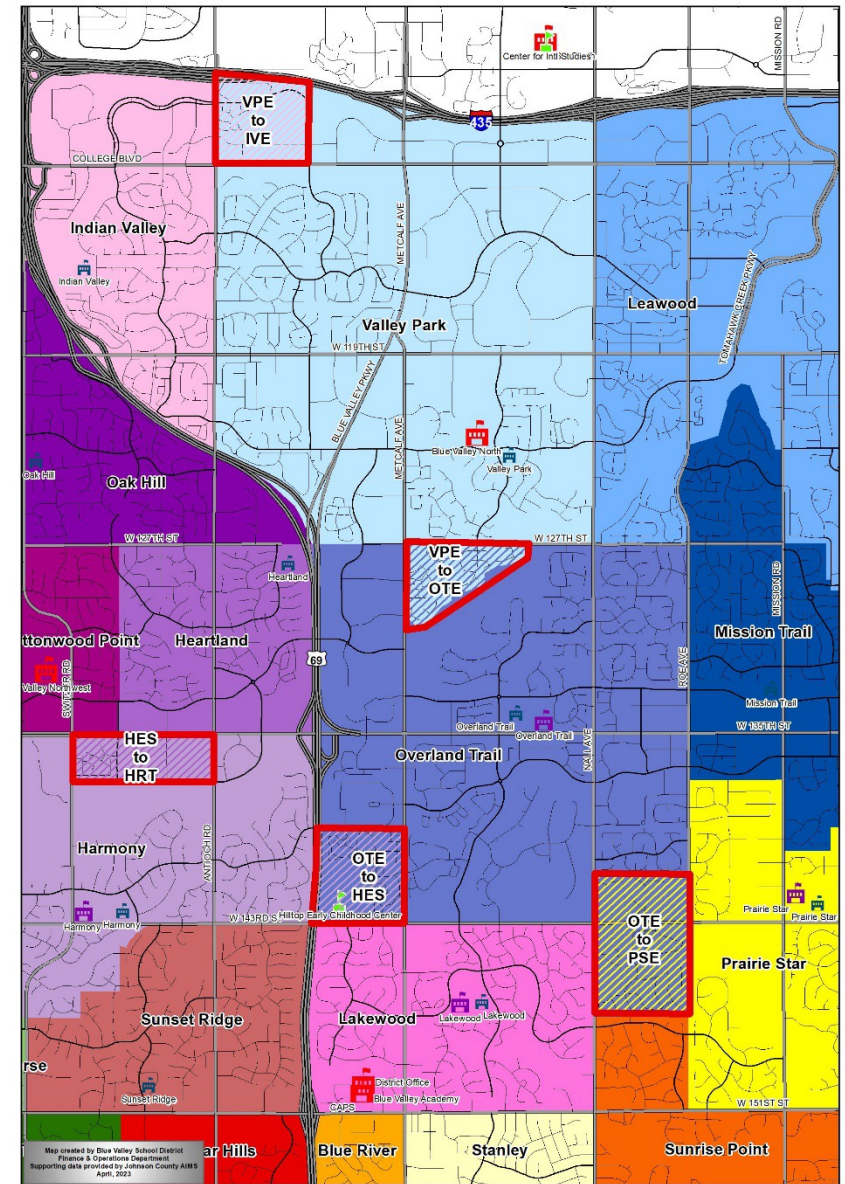
- The Facility Planning Committee conducted regular meetings in February, March, & April.
- School Newsletters to families shared the boundary recommendation in early May. Direct mailers to families who are impacted were also sent out.
- Public Hearings were held at HES, VPE, and OTE in mid-May.
- Feedback via a Google form was provided to better understand concerns.
- An internal review of the current plan occurred with consideration of patron comments.
- Administration recommends staying with the plan presented to the Board on May 8th.



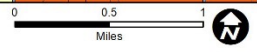

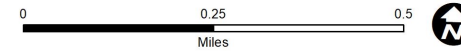
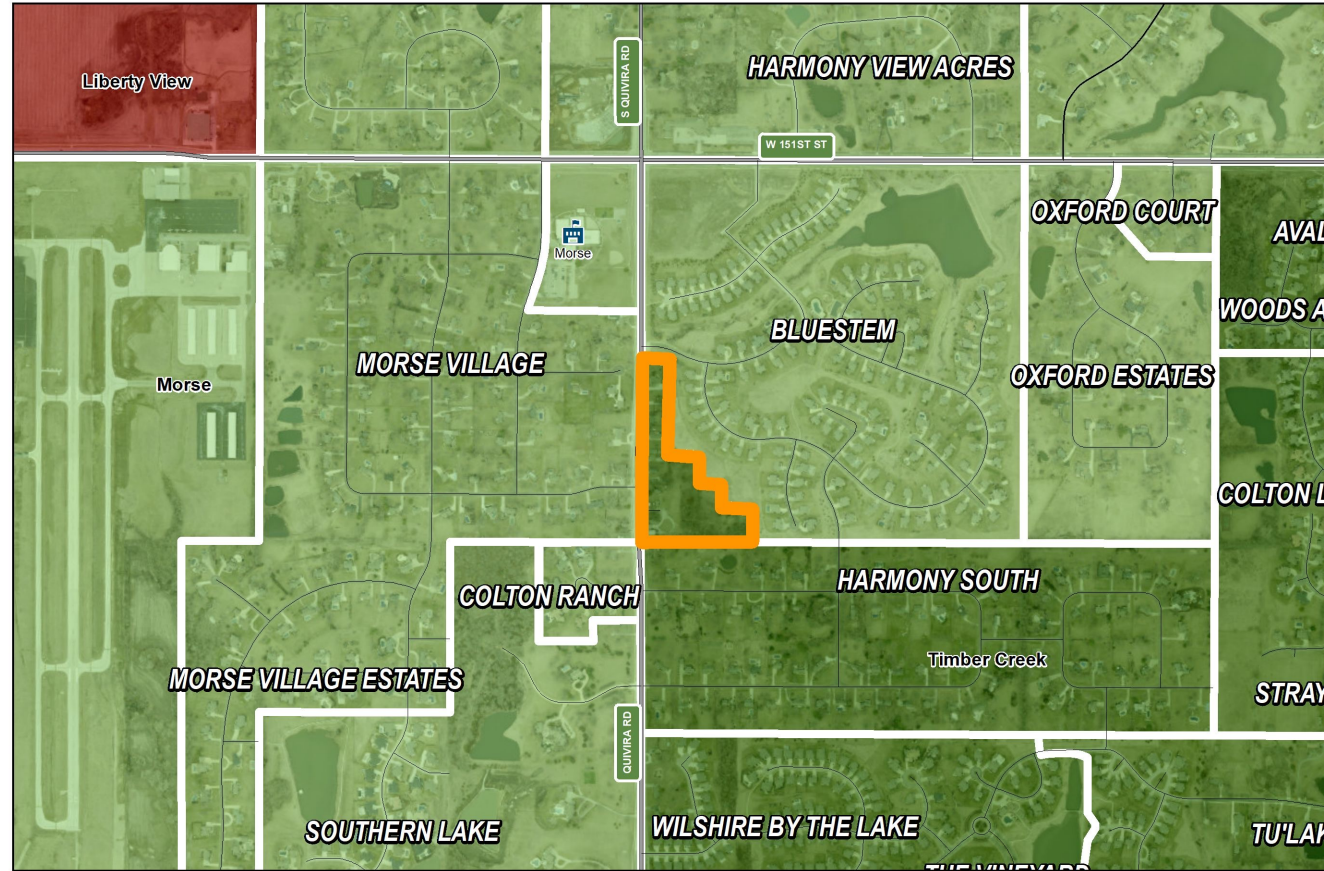

Summary of Adjusted Boundaries

- New boundaries for students at HES, OTE, and VPE would go into effect the 2024-25 school year. New boundary for TCE to MOR would go into effect the 2023-24 school year.
- Change is projected to impact 220 current and future elementary students.
- Grandfather in the students who will be 6th thru 12th graders in 2024-25 who wish to remain in their current feeder system as transfer students.
- Students in preK-4th grades will need to submit a transfer request next spring to stay at their current school. This will be considered on a case-by-case basis with a critical driver being the impact to staffing.
