Junior and senior students can work toward earning their high school diploma and associate degree simultaneously through this partnership with Johnson County Community College (JCCC). The program provides students the opportunity to attend JCCC fulltime, receive dual credit for the



The program provides students the opportunity to attend JCCC fulltime, receive dual credit for their coursework and take an average of 15 credit hours each semester at no cost to the student. Students in this program will not be eligible for KSHSAA activities or athletics. Careful course selection and ongoing communication with counselors at both JCCC and the student's home high school is necessary to ensure coursework is aligned to achieving these simultaneous credentials. JCCC entrance requirements must be met for College Algebra (ACT Math score of 26 or higher) and Composition 1 (ACT English score of 19 or higher).

## FRESHMAN AND SOPHOMORE YEARS

Foundational high school coursework focused on achieving graduation credits.

## **JUNIOR AND SENIOR YEARS**

Fulltime enrollment at JCCC in courses that fulfill remaining high school graduation requirements as well as requirements to obtain an associate degree from JCCC.

Progress toward an industry certification or associate degree.
