Science

Through a partnership with Overland Park Fire Department (OPFD) and Johnson County Community College (JCCC), students may enroll in Fire Science coursework for three hours a day over the course of four semesters.

Courses will be held at OPFD facilities and will prepare students for certification exams required to be a firefighter. Initial coursework will also cover required information to jumpstart students interested in pursuing a career as an Emergency Medical Technician.

Through this partnership, students who pass the Fire Science Entrance Exam may receive college credit for some of the coursework offered.



FRESHMAN AND SOPHOMORE YEARS

Foundational high school coursework focused on achieving graduation credits.

JUNIOR AND SENIOR YEARS

Enrollment in coursework during the school day at OPFD facilities in the areas of Fire Science and Emergency Medical Services including work-based learning, observations and ride-alongs.

Completion of high school diploma.

Readiness to take certification exams for Firefighter license and pursue additional coursework toward degree.
