Challenges of the Week

Math Challenge of the Week: Have your child draw a label these shapes:

Trapezoid, Hexagon, oval, rhombus, rectangle, triangle, circle, square

Reading Challenge of the Week: Have your child write down ALL of the character names from a book they read this week. Then have them use an adjective to describe each character they wrote down. Ask them how they came up with that adjective after they think of one! Did they use the text to help them come up with an adjective for each character?

Writing Challenge of the Week: Have your child write about 2 goods they have purchased and 2 services they (or you have) have purchased! We talked about how goods are things we buy that we can physically touch while services are when we pay to have things done for us.
