Challenges of the Week

Math Challenge of the Week: We have been working on skip counting by 2, 5, and 10's. Quite a few students struggled with counting by 2's to 50. Practice this with your child and then have them write the numbers down. For more of a challenge, have your child do this to 120 instead!

Reading Challenge of the Week: We have been working on cause and effect while we read. We talked about what causes different things to happen in the book. Have your child identify something that happened and what caused it to happen. Have them come up with at least 3 different examples of cause and effect while they read. For example:

Cause: Bobby lied to his friend. Effect: His friend was mad at him.

Cause: Susie jumped off of her bike while it was moving.

Effect: She broke her arm.

Writing Challenge of the Week: We have been talking about things we need vs. things we want. Have your child create a list of things they want for the holiday season. Then have them create a list of things they need in order to survive.
