Challenges of the Week

Math Challenge of the Week: We have been learning how to draw tens and ones in more simple ways. For groups of tens, we draw lines. For ones, we draw dots. Have your child write down 6 two-digit numbers and draw it using lines and dots. For more of a challenge, have your child do this with 3-digit numbers using a square to represent groups of 100. Here are some examples:

Reading Challenge of the Week: We continue to work on text features of non-fiction books. Have your child find a non-fiction book and identify all of the text features they can. Have them name the book and all of the text features they found (examples: caption, heading, table of contents, labels, glossary, index, bold words, maps, timelines, zoom-in, etc.).

Writing Challenge of the Week: For our 100th day of school, we made the goal to complete 100 acts of kindness before Valentine's Day! We were able to do it! Have your child write down a list of things they can do from now until the end of 1st grade as acts of kindness. Have them list at least 5 different ideas.
