Challenges of the Week

Math Challenge of the Week: We will be learning how to make numbers up to the number 120 this week. Have your child write the numbers 50-120. How do they do once they get past the number 100? Do they write the numbers correctly? *For more of a challenge, have your child write down numbers 975-1,150!*

Reading Challenge of the Week: Have your child find as many verbs (action words) as they can while they read this week. Have them write down all of the words they find in a list.

Writing Challenge of the Week: Have your child write 5 adjectives. Then have them write a short story that includes ALL 5 of those adjectives! We are working on making our stories more descriptive and interesting!
