Challenges of the Week

Math Challenge of the Week: Have your child come up with all of the ways to make 10 that they can. It can be adding numbers together or subtracting numbers from one another. See if they can find at least 6 different ways of making 10!

Reading Challenge of the Week: We have been comparing and contrasting 2 characters in books we read recently. Have your child identify 2 important characters in a book they read and figure out how they are the same and how they are different.

Writing Challenge of the Week: We have been talking a lot about fall and what it looks and feels like. Have your child come up with a story (true or not true) about themselves during the fall. For example, they may write a story about building a leaf pile with their dad. Or they can talk about going to recess and collecting leaves that had fallen off of the trees. Or they can talk about going outside while it was cold
