Play Information

The ABMS Spring Play has officially been announced at school! This year, we will proudly present Ms. Kim's Class and the Book Reports of Destiny, by Dean O'Carroll! This goofy comedy is a brand new play that has yet to be published! I've been in contact with the playwright, who is excited for us to produce it for the first time, and has plans to zoom with the cast.

The play tells the story of Ms. Kim and her elementary school classroom, who Is presenting their book reports. Four children give their reports, and as they describe their stories, actors bring the story to life for the rest of the class. Each book is a parody of a popular YA Literature genre. We have *Spy Zoo*, a take on goofy spy adventures that get way too out of hand, *Jubie K. Ruby*, a direct parody of Junie B. Jones, *The Grimm Tales of Wunzaopon*, a parody of twisted fairytales, and *Bathmat Man: The Damp Knight*, a reference to Batman and parody of superhero stories.

- Performances will be on Thursday and Friday, March 24th and 25th.
