

Congrats to Blue Valley Northwest senior, **Kevin Li** for earning notable recognition as a semifinalist in a prestigious national program. Li is among seven other Kansas students named semifinalists for the 2024 U.S. Presidential Scholars program. The U.S. Presidential Scholars program recognizes

outstanding high school seniors for their academic success, artistic excellence, leadership and demonstrated commitment to high ideals. The program, established in 1964, honors the most accomplished high school students nationwide. Each year, up to 161 students are named Presidential Scholars, representing one of the highest honors for high school students.
