UNIT 1: Digital Camera Basic	 SKILLS Identify camera parts, types, and camera formats Demonstrate how a camera operates and proper safety handling Explain the basic functions of a camera: aperture, shutter speed, ISO, focus, light metering, etc
UNIT 2: Lighting, Composition, Exposure	 Explain various types of lighting and how they affect the image quality and contrast Demonstrate an understanding of the basic rules of composition Understand the difference and how to achieve under-, over- and correct exposures
